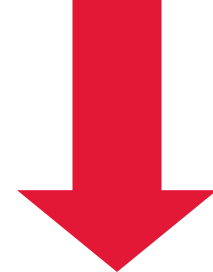


# YOUNGSTOWN STATE UNIVERSITY

Youngstown State University is where professors become both mentors and friends, offering opportunities and insight that will lead you from the lecture hall to the real world.

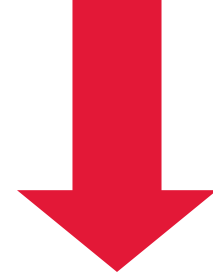

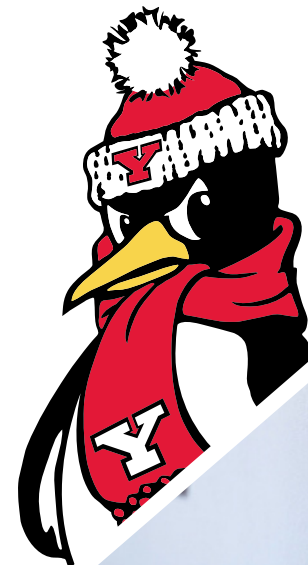

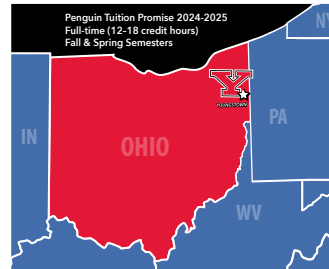

Test-optional merit-based scholarships will be awarded to incoming freshman students admitted under YSU's test-optional admission policy. Scholarships will range in value from \$1,000 to \$3,000 through the Freshman Scholarships for Excellence program. Additional \$1,000 to \$3,000 test-optional merit-based scholarships may be awarded to Honors College applicants who qualify for the Sokolov Honors College.

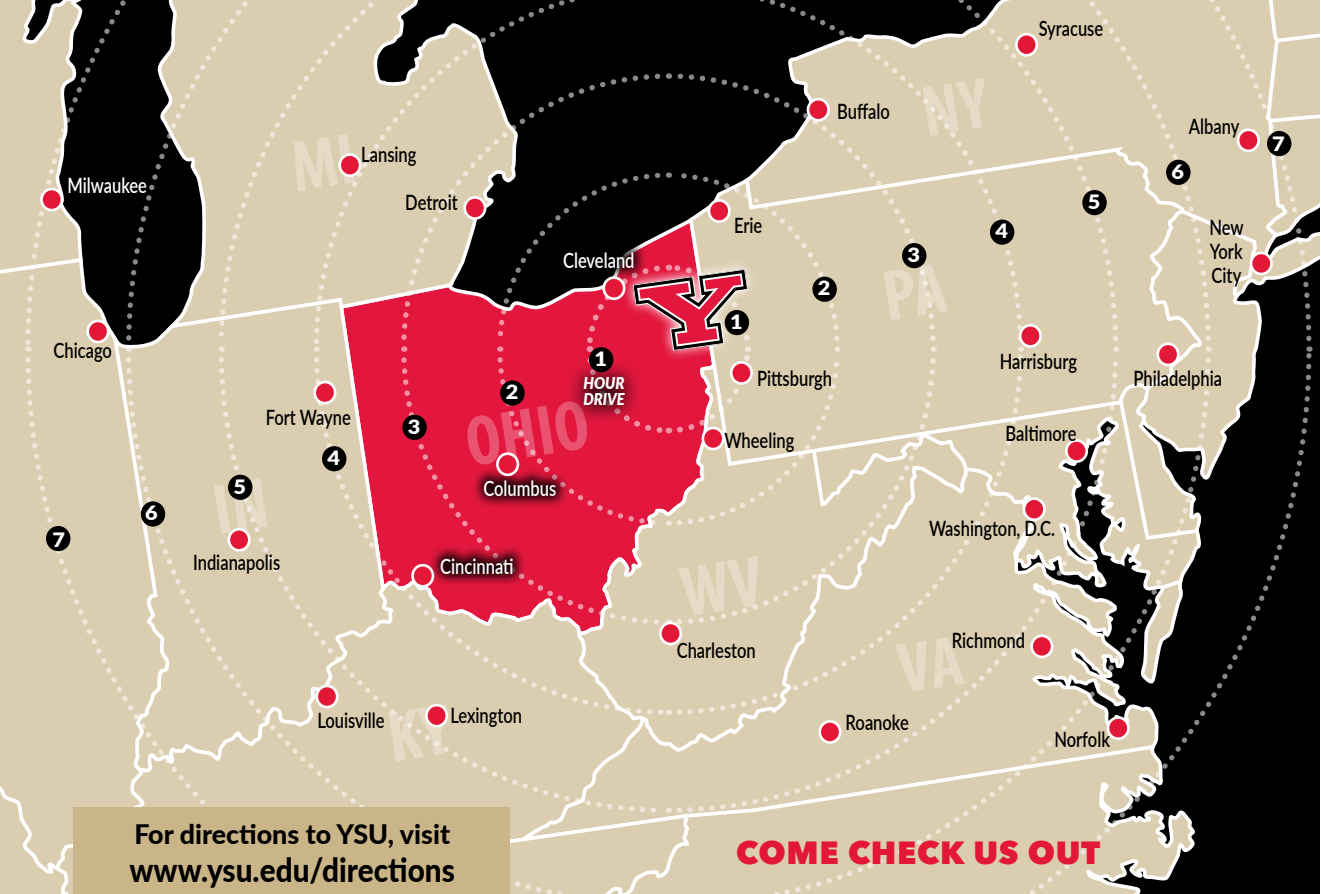
